Short description:

The WBCInno project Coordinator, University of Kragujevac, organized the WBCInno Info Day. The main focus of the event was to present the results and outcomes of the project and their relevance for the broader research community.

At the beginning of the Info Day, the participants were greeted by the Prof. Dr. Zivadin Bugarcic, Vice-Rector for the Science Research of the University of Kragujevac. The importance of this event and WBCInno initiatives was recognized and generously supported by the National Council for Science and Technology Development, with Prof. Dr. Vera Dondur at its head. The WBCInno Coordinator Prof. Dr. Vesna Mandic also welcomed the present colleagues and students and emphasized the importance of WBCInno results in the process of universities modernization and creation of innovative regions. On behalf of the WBCInno partners, Prof. Dr. Darko Petkovic from University of Zenica greeted all the present participants, as well.

The WBCInno Info Day was targeted to university professors, researchers and students. It was organisationally divided into three sessions. The first session started with the general presentation of the WBCInno results in order to introduce the participants with the progress of the WBCInno project. Afterwards, three strategic publications were presented, such as Regional University Innovation Platform, Methodology for Innovation Management with IPR aspects and Strategic Development Plan for Business Incubators and Science and Technology Parks in Western Balkan Region.

In the second session, the participants had the opportunity to learn more on how to promote their research results, activities and resources through the online Catalogue of Research and Innovation Potential of the University of Kragujevac. In this session, the representative of Centre for Career Development presented current programs for scholarships and practical placements for students. The session was closed with the presentation on how to fund research and innovative ventures within the Horizon2020 program.

After the presentation sessions, individual meetings and consultations were organized on forthcoming project calls and training and mobility programs, WBCInno activities, promotion of research, student scholarship programs, etc., when the participants could find out more details on the topics of their interest.

In the afternoon, two regional committees held their meetings at the Faculty of Engineering University of Kragujevac: Regional Committee for the University Innovation Platform and Regional Committee for Business Incubators and Science and Technology Parks.
