



- ➤ A University department has been working for more than 20 years, developing different research lines in the field of New Materials. They have thesis, scientific papers and two patents have been applied for.
- ➤ They want to open a new field of research: the material of the future with several different uses and with great interest for industry. They should get some new equipment and get the staff ready.



- ➤ A big company working on the field of vision needs some material to be used as a "glue". The material should be compatible with ocular tissues
- On the other hand we have a research group working on adhesive materials.



- ➤ A research group has the technology to produce some medicine. The technology is protected and several big companies have shown interest. The medicine could be a "revolution".
- Very competitive market
- Big investment needed to get to market





- A research group has developed a method to isolate a pharma entity in a cheaper way than the traditional way. Protection is being studied at the moment.
- The TTO has contacted different pharma companies willing to buy the entities (since they are cheaper, they can reduce costs)



➤ A research group being an expert on one specific field of knowledge. Several organizations contact them in order to get advise to write a regional development plan.



- ➤ A research group has developed a new technology patented in Spain. They want to patent in Europe too, but they don't have money.

- 2 researchers plus a person with business skills in the sector












- Design equipments in the field of energy storage
- Sector: Chemistry/Energy
- UA Department: Inorganic Chemistry
- Founders → 4 researchers
- Born with a commercial agreement with an American company









bioflytech

- Insect mass rearing to be used in animal feeding, among others
- Sector: Biotechnology
- UA Department: Environment and Natural Resources
- Founders → 3 researchers
- International focus, working on alliances









- R&D in added value products, mainly pharmaceuticals and new chemical entities with therapeutic interest.
- Sector pharma
- Sector: Organic Chemistry
- Founders: 5 researchers
