## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

---

Benchmarking visits of EU partners (University of Brighton UB, Graz University of Technology TUG, Hamburg University of Technology TUHH, University of Alicante UA and Center for Social Innovation ZSI) to WBC universities (University of Kragujevac UKG, University of Novi Sad UNS, University of Banja Luka UBL, University of Zenica UZ and University of Montenegro UM) will be realized in accordance with the plan agreed among partners, with following schedule:

- Serbia (UKG, UNS) – from 26<sup>th</sup> until 31<sup>st</sup> August 2013
- Bosnia (UBL, UZ) – from 23<sup>rd</sup> until 28<sup>th</sup> September 2013
- Montenegro (UM) – from 3<sup>rd</sup> until 6<sup>th</sup> October 2013.

The aim of these visits is to identify gaps by comparing [benchmarking metrics](#), defined on the basis of [collected 11 EU good practices](#) and consolidated report (D1.1) on one side, and the results of [mapping of WBC universities' research and innovation potential](#) presented in five catalogues in local languages and English (D1.2) on the other side.

During the visits, EU partners will perform final benchmarking assessment of existing WBC universities' structures/services in the areas of knowledge transfer, innovation and research. In order to make the process more efficient TUHH prepared a [questionnaire](#) that will be filled-in by hosting WBC institutions. Also, for specific questions TUHH prepared a list of questions for two-hour interview. Result of benchmarking visits and assessment will be presented in D.2.1 Benchmarking assessment report elaborated for each WBC university. Benchmarking reports, consisting of recommendations for improvements, will be used for current and forthcoming activities
