The WBCInno team from the University of Novi Sad organized the WBCInno Workshop entitled "Building researchers' capacities in the area of knowledge transfer, research and innovations".

At the beginning of the Workshop, the participants were welcomed by the Prof. Dr Pavle Sekeruš, Vice-Rector for Science and International Cooperation of the University of Novi Sad, Novi Sad, Serbia. The WBCInno team coordinator from University of Novi Sad, Prof. Dr Goran Stojanović presented the importance of WBCInno results in the process of universities modernization and creation of innovation regions.

The workshop is intended for teachers, researchers and university students in the Western Balkans. On the first day of the workshop, participants had the opportunity to hear examples of good practice from Europe about the transfer of knowledge and technology as well as the innovation management cycle in their institutions. The methodology for assessing the commercial possibilities for research / technology with practical exercises was also presented.

The second day of the workshop was devoted to the presentation of methodologies for managing innovation, University as an innovative platform and collaborative software platform for managing innovation that has been developed within WBCInno project, with practical exercises. In addition to this the experience in coordinating EU-funded projects was presented as well as ways how to apply for EU funds for research and innovation, especially H2020 for SMEs calls were demonstrated.
